Cheryl Scribellito graduated with honors in June 1979 from Central Regional High School in Bayville, New Jersey. From August 1977 to December 1980 she worked in the office and in sales for Bob Kislin's Sporting Goods Inc. During that time duties included accounts payable posting, payroll, balancing and posting cash receipts, processing purchase orders, shipping receipts and invoices, filing and business correspondence.

From February of 1981 until April 1989 Cheryl Scribellito worked for Reliable Pump and Well, a family owned Drilling Company. Duties at Reliable included, but were not limited to, handling accounts receivable and payable, reconciling checking accounts, filing, correspondence, customer service and collections. During that period she also attended Ocean County College in Toms River, New Jersey part-time with a 3.75 g.p.a.

In 1990, Mrs. Scribellito went to work for Spring Valley Decorating in Columbia, South Carolina. Starting in sales, then promoted to assistant manager, followed by being transferred to a new store in Lexington, S.C. as a department manager. Duties included purchasing and handling store stock of the wallpaper department as well as sales and installation for that department.
